### Remembrance Day Service

Thanks to all the students and staff who took part in the Remembrance Day Service on Wednesday. The students have made some wonderful wreaths to place under the Memorial board in the BER building. Thanks to the School Captains for running the service and to Steph B for stepping in at the last minute. The presentations from each class were very moving and were a suitable tribute to all those who have served or are continuing to serve in the armed forces.



### Fire Drill

Just to let you know that we conducted a Fire Drill yesterday. This went very smoothly and we completed a safe evacuation in just over 5 minutes. These drills help us plan for an Emergency situation and identify areas where we can improve our response. These drills are very important but can cause some children distress and concern and they may need some reassurance about this event. Please talk to your child about the reason for these drills and how it is very important to follow the instructions of the teacher at all times.



### School Structure

Over the last few weeks we have been working to organise the School structure for next year. This has included all the possibilities that would work within the budget that we are allocated by the Department. The difficulty with planning is that our budget is only finalised on the 28<sup>th</sup> February dependent on the amount of students that we have in our school on that date. We have to use our Jedi mind powers to work through solutions and ideas that ensure we put in place a structure that ensures flexibility in case our numbers change between now and then but also fits with the budget. As you know 2020 has stopped a great deal of our school activities including School Tours and Open Days this has limited our ability to sell our school and its programs across the area. As such due to over 50 students leaving the school from Grade 6 our numbers will be lower than this year. As such we are looking to move to a 10 class system which again focuses on lower class numbers but also recognises the difficulties the students have faced over the last year. We will release details of this structure as soon as it has been confirmed by School Council next week. The placement of staffing will then take place in the coming weeks.

### Tutoring Program

As you are aware the Department is putting in place a tutoring program for students who have been deemed to find remote learning difficult and have not progressed as much as would have been expected in 2020. We are now in the process of putting this program together and identifying the students from all year levels and all abilities to take part in this program. We will release details of this program and what its scope of work will be once we have discussed the logistics of organising this in our school.
